

Summary 5-24-10

The final HHS late-arrival for the 2009-2010 school year took place on May 24th and featured teachers working with their PLT's to continue the RTI plan. Teachers met to review the lists of subject specific vocabulary they had previously developed and came up with plans on how to implement the vocabulary into the curriculum. HHS officially begins RTI next fall and will use it as a tool to help students who may require extra help with their academic skills. Teachers also used the time to make final edits and revisions to their finals and entered them into the Scantron Achievement Series. The PLT late-arrivals will continue next year with a continuing focus on the College Readiness Skills, the Common Core State Standards, and RTI. Data from this spring's PSAE, IACT and PLAN testing will be reviewed to make informed data-driven decisions on curriculum and best-practices in the classroom.
